Dear Parents,

We are going to start a "Share Bag" and "Book Bag" program next week,

August 24,2022. We have an alphabatized list according to their first names posted in the classroom. Each child will have a turn bringing home the share bag or book bag. When your child brings home a "bag", follow the directions and return the bag the next school day. Your child will share what is in the share bag through a group sharing language activity. We will be building language and questioning skills during this activity. If your child has the book bag, I will read their favorite book during our read aloud time or during "ALOHA" circle. Feel free to visit your local library and find a variety of books to fit your child's interest and level.

Book Bag Rules:

Bring a book that your child has picked out. Please bring age appropriate reading material. I will also remind them to bring a storybook because it allows us to discuss different elements of the book.

Share Bag Rules:

Our share bag is designed to hold a special personal object that your child will share with the class. Our children will learn how to handle objects with care, talk about colors, shapes, sounds, and feelings during this time. **NO** guns, knives/swords, or fighting actions figures. We want to promote a peaceful and friendly school/class environment.
